Whereas there has been deposited in the GENERAL LAND OFFICE of the United States a CERTIFICATE of the Register of the Land Office at Crookston, whereby it appears that, pursuant to the Act of Congress approved 20th May, 1862, "To secure Homesteads to actual settlers on the public domain," and the acts supplemental thereto, the claim of Peter O. Stone has been established and duly consummated in conformity to law for the Lots numbered two four and five and the  $\frac{7}{8}$  South East quarter of the South West quarter of Section eighteen in Township one hundred and fifty three North of Range forty-two West of the Fifth Principal Meridian in Minnesota containing one hundred and sixty-three acres and ten hundredths of an acre -

according to the Official Plat of the Survey of the said Land returned to the GENERAL LAND OFFICE by the SURVEYOR GENERAL.

Now know ye, That there is therefore granted by the UNITED STATES unto the said Peter O. Stone the tract of Land above described: TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said tract of Land, with the appurtenances thereof, unto the said Peter O. Stone and to his heirs and assigns forever. And there is reserved from the lands hereby granted a right of way thereon for ditches or canals constructed by the authority of the United States.
